BAYFEST 2014 TICKETS AVAILABLE AUGUST 1

MARINE CORPS BASE HAWAII – BayFest tickets will go on sale to the public Friday, Aug. 1 at www.BayFestHawaii.com. Authorized patrons may also purchase tickets at any military ticket outlet beginning the same day. BayFest is Oct. 17-19 aboard Marine Corps Base Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay and includes three days of music and family fun.

A general admission ticket provides access to the E.K. Fernandez carnival and midway, sponsor expo, GNC BodySearch Fitness Competition, food booths, military displays, new car displays, and fireworks (Friday only). Concert tickets for each evening include general admission. A new ticket is required each day for entry to BayFest. Concert tickets purchased within the first two weeks receive a special early bird rate.

BayFest hours Friday, Oct. 17 are 5 p.m. to 1 a.m. and will feature a fireworks display in between musical acts Uncle Kracker and Smash Mouth. Saturday hours are noon to 1 a.m. with the GNC BodySearch Fitness Competition at 3 p.m. and Capital Cities performing in the evening. Sunday hours are noon to 10 p.m., with a musical act to be announced. Concert gates will open at 5 p.m. and music will start each night with the U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Pacific Band.

E.K. Fernandez rides will be open until midnight Friday and Saturday and 10 p.m. Sunday. Boat rides to and from Coconut Island will be available Saturday and Sunday from noon to 6 p.m. Concert goers can stay after the concert until 1 a.m. on Friday and Saturday to enjoy the Fest Tent.

BayFest is an annual event hosted by Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS) and MCB Hawaii. MCCS provides morale, welfare and recreation programs and services which contribute to readiness and retention of Marines, sailors and family members stationed aboard MCB Hawaii.
