VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR BAYFEST 2014

MARINE CORPS BASE HAWAII (MCB Hawaii), Kaneohe Bay, September 29, 2014 – BayFest organizers are seeking military and civilian volunteers to assist with [BayFest 2014](#), taking place from Friday, October 17 through Sunday, October 19 at MCB Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay. Volunteer opportunities onsite include:

- **Drivers:** Drivers are needed to shuttle musical artists to and from the concert venue. Qualified persons must be 18 years or older and have a valid driver's license. Priority goes to active duty service members rank E5 and below.
- **Food and Beverage:** Volunteers will be serving food and/or beverages. In order to serve alcoholic beverages, volunteers must be at least 21 years old. Food workers should be at least 16 years old.
- **Ticketing:** These volunteers welcome patrons to BayFest. Volunteers may also be wrist-banding and taking tickets at the entry.
- **ID Checkpoints and Gate Security:** ID checkpoint volunteers must be 21 years or older and will be enforcing drinking policies. Gate security volunteers will ensure only proper personnel are backstage. Backstage volunteers may also be requested to assist as stage hands. Should be able to lift approximately 40 pounds. Must be at least 18 years old to work in this area.
- **Marketing:** Volunteers at least 16 years old are needed to help with advertising distribution.
- **Contest support:** GNC BodySearch Competition.

Various shifts are available. All volunteers receive admission to the general BayFest attractions, event t-shirt, meal coupon and letter or certificate of appreciation. To volunteer in food and beverage, please call (808) 254-7638. To volunteer in all other areas, contact (808) 257-7786.

BayFest is open to the public October 17-19 and hosted by Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS) and MCB Hawaii. Highlights include three nights of concerts by national recording artists on the USAA Main Stage. Friday, October 17th features Smash Mouth and Uncle Kracker.
